

## Call for Application

### Re: Training Workshop for MDAs, CSOs, Women, Youths & Community Leaders on Preventing Conflict-Related Sexual & Gender-Based Violence (SGBV)

#### Introduction

The Civil Resource Development and Documentation Centre (CIRDDOC) in partnership with the Community & Youth Development Initiatives (CYDI) is seeking a qualified training facilitator to design and deliver a training program for selected stakeholders - MDAs, CSOs, Women, Youths and Community Leaders on **Preventing Conflict-Related SGBV**. This is coming under its "Strengthening Capacity and Oversight on the Use of Human Rights Principles in the Prevention of Conflict-Related SGBV" project, with support from Ford Foundation.

#### Objectives

The 2-day training workshop for 35 stakeholders from Imo state is aimed at deepening participants' understanding of conflict-related SGBV, its forms, impact, and consequences, and equipping participants with the knowledge, skills, and strategies to prevent SGBV in conflict settings. **Specific Objectives include:**

1. To raise awareness about the root causes, forms, and consequences of SGBV in conflict settings, with particular focus on Imo state.
2. To develop participants' skills in preventing SGBV, including community engagement, advocacy, and support services.
3. To enhance coordination and collaboration among CSOs, government agencies, and other stakeholders to prevent SGBV.
4. To equip participants with the skills and knowledge to advocate for policies and practices that prevent conflict and SGBV.
5. To emphasize the importance of community-led initiatives and inclusive leadership in preventing SGBV.

#### Key Responsibilities

1. Examine challenges (issues for advocacy) and opportunities to preventing Conflict-Related SGBV in the state
2. Develop a comprehensive training program and resource materials that will deliver the above objectives, covering the concepts of conflict-related SGBV, human rights principles and extant laws, research findings (facts and statistics) relating to conflict & SGBV in the state, SGBV advocacy, etc
3. Facilitate the training sessions, using interactive and engaging methods to ensure participants understand and apply the concepts

#### Requirements

1. Proven experience in designing and delivering related training programs
2. In-depth knowledge of the state vis-à-vis policies and practices, SGBV, conflict situation, etc
3. Ability to facilitate interactive and engaging training sessions.
